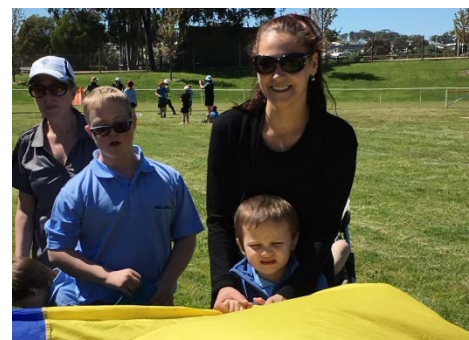

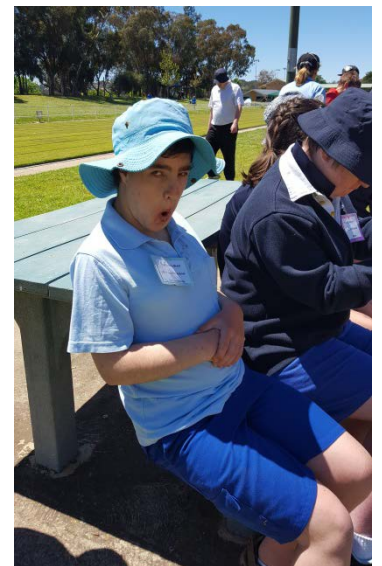




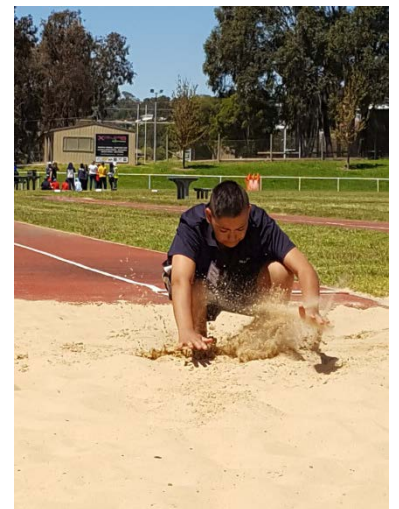
We had the athletics carnival.

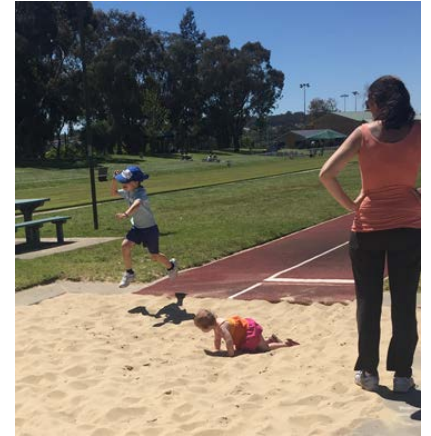
