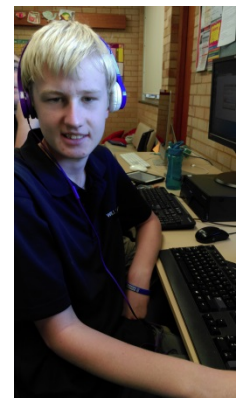
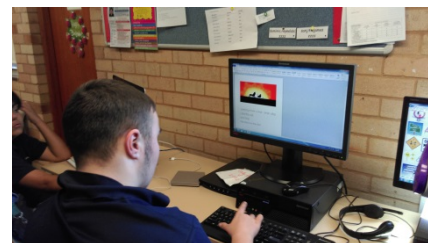
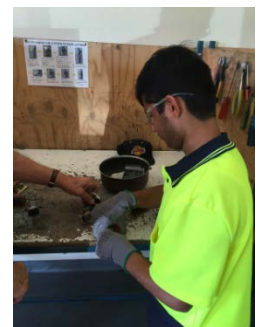
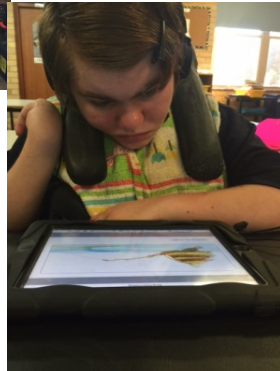
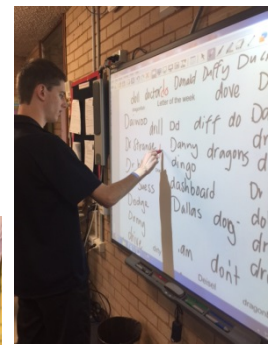
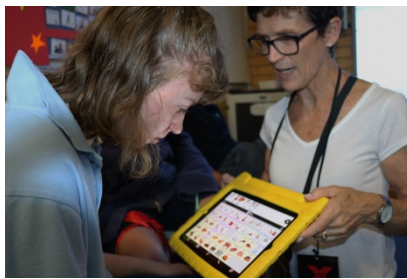


Emily Whittaker is WOW of the Week

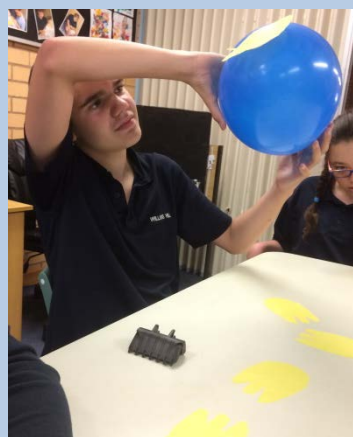
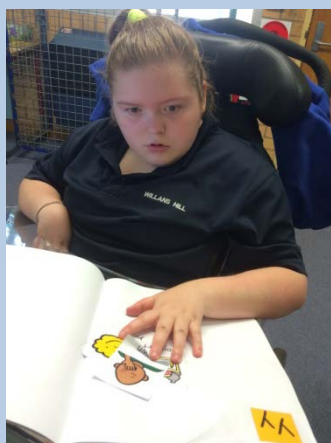
