Caleb has been displaying a positive attitude to a new placement for work experience.

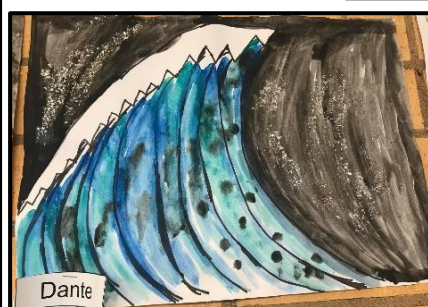
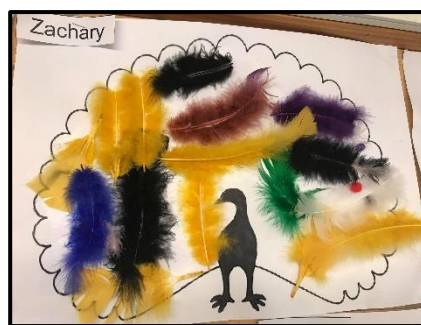
