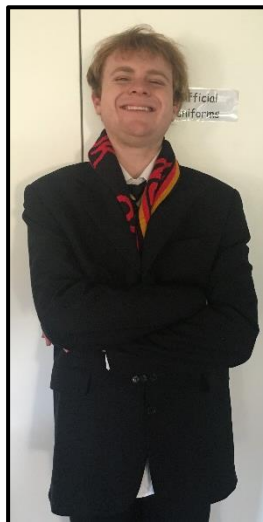

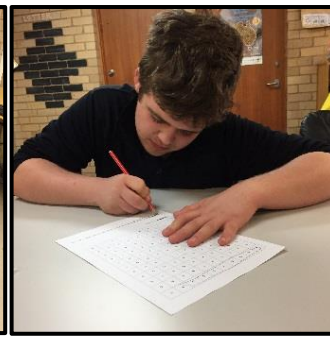

Parents/carers are welcome to attend.

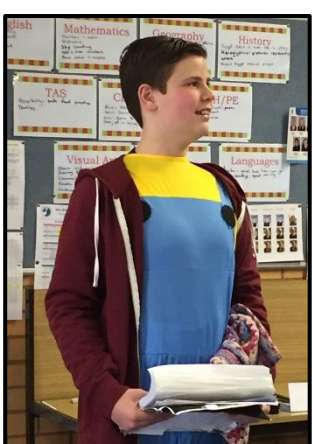
Late Arrivals and Early Departures
