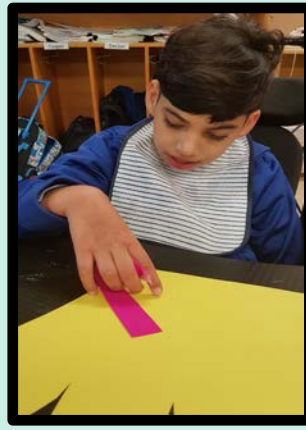

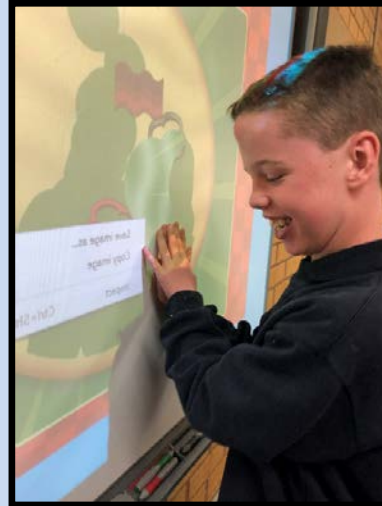
During Creative Arts, Class 3 has been studying artwork by Ken Done.
